

#### **Doctor of Divinity**

Cheryl is the head of a new ministry called Chosen Generation Ministry International. Here she shares how Summit Bible College was able to uniquely meet her educational needs to prepare her for God's purpose.

I have had to come through many challenges during these last three years at Summit Bible College, by the grace of God.

Now I can pour oil into others. I am excited about what God is birthing in my spirit as I move forward in establishing a grief and loss workshop for the community. I must add, it's also a blessing to graduate college and not have to spend years paying off educational debt.

I would also like to express my gratitude for the love and support of all the ones who rallied at different points to help me with all those papers and encouraged me that I could do it. Finally, I am grateful for the entire staff at Summit Bible College and I commend everyone for their labor of love, serving our Lord. 



## DEVOTIONAL



In the passage above, God is offering the nation of Israel an opportunity to participate in the "new thing" He's going to be doing among them. However, with the invitation comes a question that is just as relevant to today's believer: "Shall you not know it?" In other words, before we participate in what God is doing, we have to recognize it. God warns them not to look to the past for a recognizable or familiar pattern to determine what He is about to do.

Too often when we use the word "new" we think of the latest in a series, like the new car that rolled out for 2019. However, in the scriptures, "new" often means something you've never seen before. Past is not necessarily prologue, and we have to be willing to step away from the familiar to embrace our new future. Too often God's people are unable to step away from what God did to embrace what God is doing.

It's fascinating to me that even during the active years of Jesus' ministry, there were still disciples of John the Baptist running around. Why? John himself had told the people that he was only sent to prepare the way for the

one who was to come. Still, we see disciples of John following a past move of God while the very thing He sought to reveal to the world was walking in their midst.

I would imagine some of them would have said, "Yes, but I'm comfortable with John! I like his style." Others might have said, "Yes, but I finally got a position on John' staff!" Others might have objected, "I've got a lot invested here! I can't just walk away from all I've worked for!" The disciples of Jesus did, however. The scripture says, "They immediately left their nets and followed Him" (Matthew 4:20). Anytime we choose to follow God's direction for our lives, it means leaving something else behind. The only question is, are we willing to forsake the familiar in favor of His future for our lives.

The Lord once spoke to me in regard to this. He said, "It's better to be a Private in what I'm doing than a General in what I did." God may be asking you to step out in unknown territory. That's ok. He can make a way in the wilderness and open a path where there hasn't been one before. Why would He ask you to do this? To bring rivers of water to those still in the desert.



We've all seen the rise of a strident secularism in the west, and in America in particular, which has threatened to undermine the biblical foundations upon which our nation was built. We see the aggressiveness with which media pundits and politicians attack people of faith who stand for biblical principles in the public square. To be sure, the pressures we feel from the world are real, but not all the problems are external.

A recent study from Barna shows that a large group of American Christians are more *ready* than they are *willing* to share their faith. About three-quarters of the nations Millennials say they feel equipped to share their faith, and yet an alarming number (47%) feel that it is in some measure *wrong* to "share one's personal beliefs with someone of a different faith in hopes that they will one day share the same faith." This, no doubt, comes from the cultural move toward pluralism and political correctness but is an obviously erroneous perspective in the light of the Great Commission Christ gave the Church to make disciples of all nations.

Other problems abound, but the mistake is to focus on the negatives when in reality, the Church has always been a counter-cultural movement. Great challenges should simply signal to us that there are also great opportunities to be difference makers in our world. There are a number of things regarding the Church's work that have remained the same.

First of all, "the harvest is still great." Jesus told the disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few" (Matthew 9:37). That is still true today. There is no shortage on the demand, only on the supply. There is "job security" for us all. There is room enough for laborers in every field of endeavor, regardless of ones ministry focus or occupation. In other words, we can all be harvest reapers regardless of how and where we serve the Lord. The fields are still "white unto harvest," and we are all missionaries in the particular world to which we've been called.

Secondly, the Holy Spirit is still present to empower us for the work we are called to do. Gospel work is a joint venture between God and His people. We do not do this in our own strength. Jesus told the disciples that they would receive power when the Holy Spirit came upon them (Acts 1:8), and that He would empower them to reach the world. The same holds true for us today.

Lastly, regardless of how many empty wells men may visit to try to slake their thirst, only Christ has those living waters which satisfy the soul of man. It is this reality that should always embolden un to share our faith, even in the face of seemingly overwhelming opposition. After all, the gates of hell shall not prevail against the Church of Jesus Christ!
